

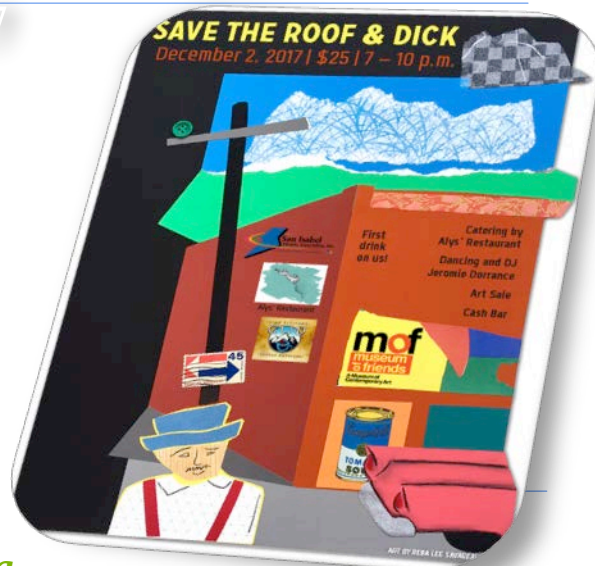

Biennial Report

2016 and 2017

History Colorado's Support put MOF's 'Roof & Dick' Building on the State Register of Historic Buildings. After that first step MOF was awarded a Historic Structural Assessment for Architecture and Engineering in 2016 and in 2017 a State Historic Fund Grant. Continued normal operations included changing exhibits & education programs progressed. In the last 13 years MOF has made the following strides: a. increased impact and visibility while helping to build our community's civic pride by: the re-purposing of the historic Downtown 'Roof & Dick' building and recognition from Historic Preservation and History Colorado; MOF's value as a Huerfano County cultural amenity with national attention; growing interest in the art history of Southern Colorado and the works in MOF's permanent collection; and socially engaged children's and family programs.

MOF's goal to involve our community through expanded outreach programs and exhibits designed to increase impact through interesting social engagement continues to evolve.



Founded in 2007:

The Museum of Friends' mission is to "honor the artists who have freely given art to the museum's founders thereby establishing its collection. MOF honors art and celebrates the generous artists who made possible and gave form to its existence. MOF's primary goals are to foster the open inquiry necessary for a cultural education and its ideals through exhibitions, public and educational programs, while sharing an extensive reference library and permanent collection,

Phase One Restoration - Exterior Masonry, Elevator

The proposed project includes a scope of work that addresses critical issues identified in the Historic Structure Assessment. All work will be detailed to comply with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties. Where applicable, recommendations in the National Park Service's Preservation Briefs will be followed, particularly those concerning masonry rehabilitation. Work to be completed by September 2019.



FOUNDATION REHABILITATION:

The foundation of the building is constructed of coursed rubble stone ashlar. The stone is soft sandstone, and appears to be the same type of stone found on the exterior of the building, which has eroded where water has penetrated from the exterior to the interior of the building. Areas of localized deterioration including stone delamination and erosion are present due to long term moisture migration through the foundation walls. If untreated, this on-going deterioration may result in localized failures of the stone foundation walls.

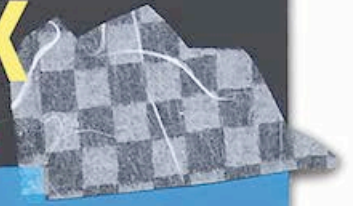

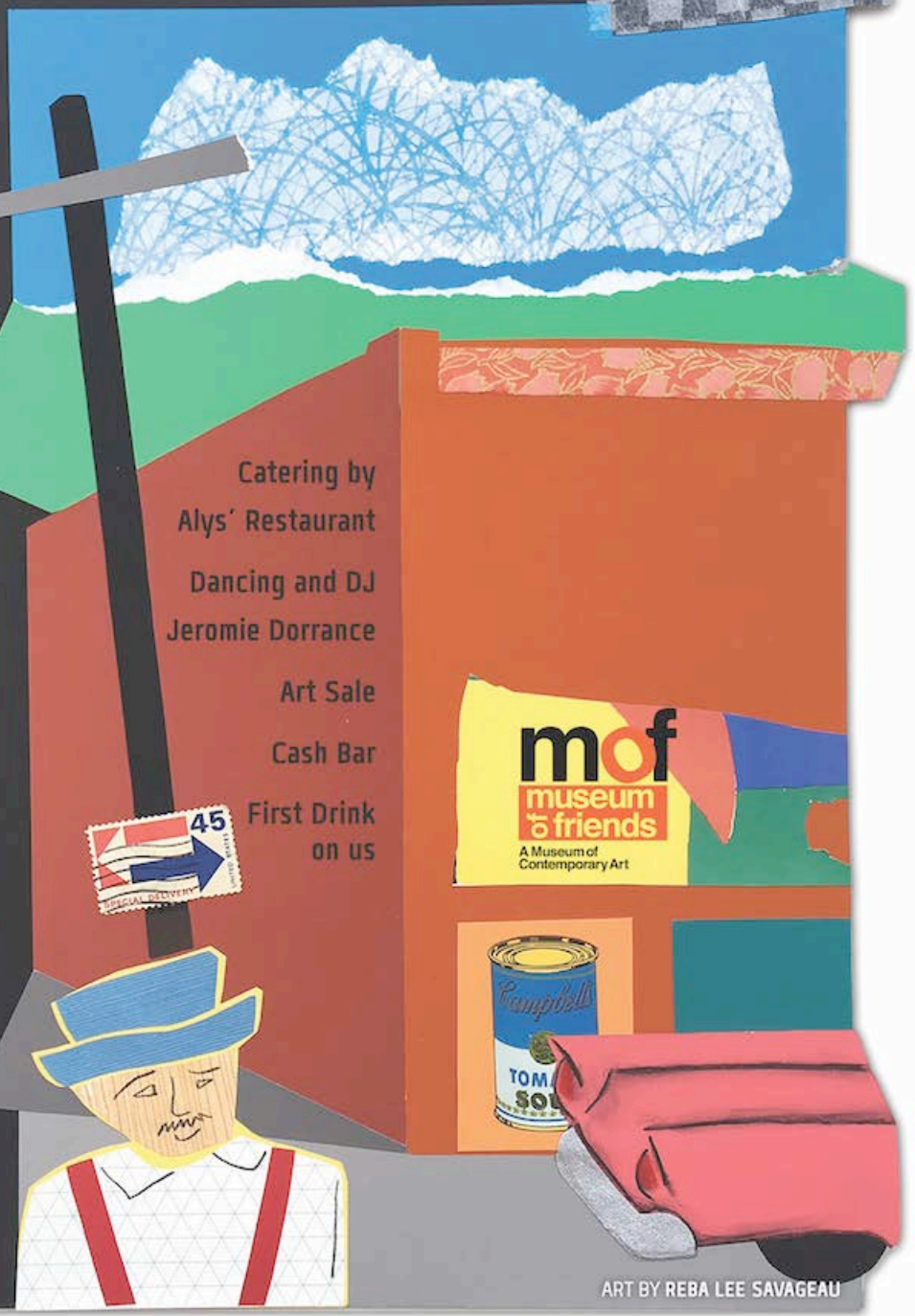
